Commitment to achieving net zero

Elevate Healthcare (UK) is committed to achieving net zero greenhouse gas emissions across its UK operations by **2050 at the latest**, in line with the UK Government's national target and the minimum net zero year required under [PPN 006](#) and the [NHS Net Zero Supplier Roadmap](#).

Baseline emissions footprint

This is Elevate Healthcare (UK)'s first Carbon Reduction Plan. A formal Scope 1, 2 and 3 greenhouse gas inventory has not yet been compiled for the UK entity.

Baseline year: 2026

Explanation for data not yet available: As a new entrant to NHS Supply Chain tendering, Elevate Healthcare (UK) has not previously been required to produce a Carbon Reduction Plan and has not yet completed formal emissions measurement. The framework's guidance explicitly permits submission of a CRP with an explanation of why data is unavailable, together with a plan and timescale for closing the gap — this Plan is submitted on that basis.

Minimum-viable 12-month data collection plan: Elevate Healthcare (UK)'s in-scope operations are a single leased office (no owned vehicles, no on-site manufacturing or fuel combustion), so the required Scope 1, 2 and 3 data can be gathered from records that already exist, without commissioning a new audit or measurement programme.

This sequencing prioritizes the categories obtainable from a single email or data pull (Scope 2, business travel, commuting) ahead of the one category needing a new internal ask (freight/logistics), so partial figures can be added to this Plan progressively rather than waiting for all six rows to close before publishing any real data.

Environmental management measures in effect

- Hybrid/remote working reducing UK commuting emissions
- Consolidated shipping/logistics and where possible drop shipping to final location for equipment to reduce transportation emissions

Future carbon reduction initiatives

- Complete first full Scope 1/2/3 baseline within 12 months (see plan above).
- Prepare for the NHS's tightened April 2027 requirement for suppliers to report **global** (not just UK) Scope 1–3 emissions, and the 2028 move toward product-level carbon footprinting for individual devices supplied. [NHS England, Greener NHS – Suppliers](#)
- Review annually and update this Plan at each 12-month cycle, as required for continued Evergreen and CRP compliance.

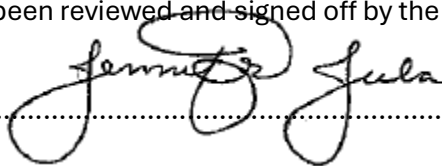
Declaration and sign off
