1. Overview of the AI Video Analysis Feature

The AI Video Analysis feature is designed to enhance the review and navigation of recorded simulations in LearningSpace. It automatically generates annotations that highlight identified clinical actions and key moments, as well as chapters that organize the video into relevant sections.

By enabling this feature, you consent to the transmission and processing of relevant video and audio data using Microsoft Azure's US-based cloud services.

2. Data Processing and Conditions for AI Video Analysis

- **Conditions for AI Video Analysis:** The AI Video Analysis feature will only process a video when the following conditions are met:
 - A video of a simulated event has been recorded.
 - The AI Video Analysis setting is enabled in your LearningSpace instance.
- **Data Transmission and Processing:** When the above conditions are satisfied, LearningSpace will transmit the associated video, including its audio content, to Microsoft Azure's cloud services for processing. Microsoft Azure will analyze the content and automatically generate annotations and chapters based on identified actions and key moments in the recording.
- **Data Retention and Deletion:**
 - **AI-Generated Annotations and Chapters:** Once the generated annotations and chapters are returned to your LearningSpace instance, they are securely stored in LearningSpace.
 - **Deletion from the Cloud Environment:** The copy of the video transmitted for processing will be deleted from the Microsoft Azure cloud environment within 24 hours after the analysis is completed.
